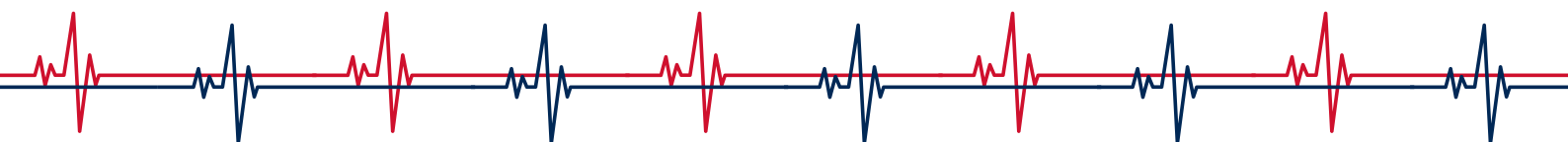

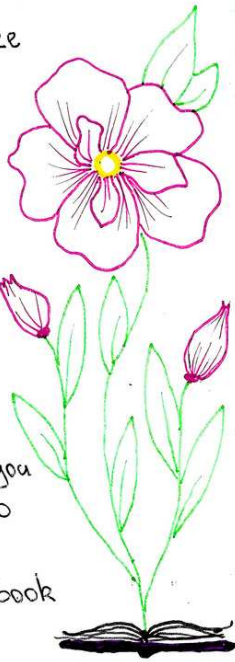
Oh, what a priceless treasure
